Project Summary

Carried out across seven sites the contract involved external hard and soft landscaping and environmental improvement schemes across social and sheltered housing stock at locations within North Somerset.

The smallest of these schemes involved the alteration of parking spaces at less than £10,000 in value, the largest being the complete external re-development around 4 blocks of flats that extended to £240,000 in value.

All residential premises remained occupied during the works, requiring a considerate and friendly approach to the residents and the work by all of our staff, operatives and sub-contractors.

Key Elements of work

- Taking up and removal of existing hard and soft surfaces, removal of old street furniture and fences.
- Excavations, including many small and difficult to access areas, importing of hardcore and topsoil filling to suite the new landscape designs.
- Construction of retaining and boundary walls and numerous flights of steps, masonry, paving and in-situ concrete construction.
- Kerbs, edgings and paving in tarmac, in-situ concrete, paving slabs, concrete block pavers and decorative gravel surfaces and road markings.
- Installation of new fencing, handrails, seating, bollards, gates, bin store areas and cycle shelters.
- At all times working in close co-ordination with the local authority housing managers and residents.
